

STRAWBERRY FIELDS EVENT NOTES

Event management is one area that RTS specialises in. Cycle events, football grand finals, Big Bash Cricket, and Anzac Day Celebrations.

In regards to the Strawberry Fields Event, 8 qualified Traffic Controllers will be on site to monitor and control the 5 narrow causeways and bridges to ensure public safety.

Times the site will be manned are set out below:

Thursday 16 November 1pm to 8pm - 500 vehicles incoming
Friday 17 November 11am to 8pm - 1000-1200 vehicles incoming
Monday 20 November 8am to 4pm - Approx 1700 vehicles outgoing

All traffic controllers are trained to identify peak traffic conditions and who should receive precedence in these situations so as to not create end of queue collisions or confusion. As per the TCP, a 60km zone will be erected at both far reaches of the designated area with traffic control points located on Lower River Road.

All class 1 signage utilised on the worksite will be removed daily, and erected prior to the next shift. All traffic controllers communicate via a designated channel on UHF – this is determined at the toolbox talk prior to works.

VMS boards are to be erected prior to the event as per arrangement.

Emergency Service vehicles have priority at all times, and all traffic will be halted to allow emergency access if required.

If requested, Berrigan Shire can receive copies of the Traffic Control Cards of the team members proposed to conduct the works.
