



38. STREET AND PUBLIC PLACE NAMING POLICY

Aim: To facilitate appropriate names for streets and public places within the Shire

Objectives:

1. To have clearly recognisable street names and public places.
2. To enable easy travel within the Shire.
3. To facilitate access to all properties by emergency vehicles.
4. To clearly identify public places.
5. To recognise places and people with historic, scenic or cultural significance.
6. To reduce conflict.

Principles:

1. *Streets and public places should be named after people or places with historic, scenic or cultural significance.*
2. *Streets should not be named after living people.*
3. *Streets with the same name should be continuous.*
4. *Any existing streets with physical divisions should have sections renamed only following public consultation and consideration of submissions.*
5. *The section of the street with the most properties should retain the existing name.*
6. *Streets in new subdivisions will be named by Council following developer input.*
7. *Public places will be named by Council after seeking community input.*

Standards:

1. Clearly visible street signs are to be erected at a standard incorporating Berrigan Shire Council logo with black on white luminous background.
2. Other public places are to be clearly identified at a compatible standard dependent on the specific conditions of the site.
