5.2 APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT A GRAIN BUNKER

STRATEGIC OUTCOME: Diverse and resilient business STRATEGIC OBJECTIVE: 4.2 Strengthen and diversify the

RECOMMENDATION NO. 1 - that Development Application No. 45/15/DA/D3 for a Grain Bunker be approved subject to the following conditions:

1. Approved Plans

The development shall be implemented substantially in accordance with the details set out on the plans provided and on the application form and on any supporting information received with the application except as amended by the conditions specified hereunder.

2. Internal roads

All roads within the site must be constructed to an all weather standard incorporating effective drainage measures and be suitably maintained so as to cater for the anticipated traffic movements and to minimize noise impacts in the locality.

Dust

Dust suppression measures must be implemented to mitigate the generation of dust when the site is in operation to ensure that nuisance to adjacent residential properties is minimised.

Management of the site

The site must be maintained at all times so that grain refuse does not contribute to infestations of mice, birds and other vermin and to protect the amenity of adjacent residents.

3. Hours of operation

The hours of operation of the facility are restricted to 6.00am - 8.00pm to ensure that the amenity of adjacent residents is maintained.

4. <u>Landscaping</u>

Landscaping of the southern boundary of the site incorporating solid fencing and the planting of screening vegetation must be undertaken so as to assist in mitigating the impacts of noise and dust upon adjacent residential properties and for the general enhancement of the locality.

5. Construction of bunker

The construction of the bunker must not encroach Lot 2 DP 777958 until such time as the land has been purchased or contracts have been signed to facilitate the transfer of that land.

6. Stormwater

All stormwater runoff from the site must be directed to the onsite retention basin and not cause nuisance to adjoining properties. In this regard it must be ensured that the retention basin has sufficient capacity to collect and store runoff from storm events.

7. Property access

Vehicular access to the site is restricted to the main entrance from Strathvale Road. No access to the site is to be obtained from Jerilderie Street or William Street without the prior approval of Council.
