REPORT:

The following rates and charges resolutions will, if adopted, implement the Council's intended rating model to achieve an overall permissible increase to Ordinary Rate income of 2.6% in line with the Rate Peg set by the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal.



The increase in annual and user charges vary according to the required revenue income required.

The making of rates and charges must be made by resolution of Council, pursuant to Sections 534 and 535 of the *Local Government Act 1993*, as set out below

Details as to how and where these rates and charges will be levied are shown in the Statement of Revenue Policy included in the Berrigan Shire Council Operational Plan 2020/21.

REPORT:

Per the provisions of the Local Government Act, 1993 (s403 – 404) Council's suite of integrated plans was placed on public exhibition (27 May 2020) for 28 days with public comment and submissions sought until 5:00pm 18 June 2020.

No formal submissions were received during the period of public exhibition however, it was particularly evident that the publication of the Council's draft suite of plans prompted extensive social media comment from residents and ratepayers.

This comment requested that the Council in response to the COVID19 pandemic and the multiple shocks that this has generated consider a number of community development and economic development projects which include:

- Saving the Barooga Gym
- Extending its street beautification program



Changes to the appended plans from those endorsed by the Council for public exhibition therefore include the addition of the following Annual Operational Plan actions:

Action

- 1.1.3.3 Identify and develop high profile sites that will accelerate town centre activation and beautification
- 3.1.2.1.2 Contribute to the operations of the indoor Pool and Gym owned and operated by the Barooga Sports Club Ltd in accordance with conditions identified by Council Resolution

Noted in the budget in the appended Operational Plan 2020/21 is the funding for these two actions. Specifically the Council has set aside \$170,000 to acquire land in Murray St, Finley for future open space in line with its strategy to activate the Finley central business district. Also included is \$50,000 (per annum for a two year period) toward the cost of operating the Barooga indoor pool and gym.

Minor changes to the Council's revenue and rating the subject of a separate report to the Council are also included in the appended Operational Plan 2020/21 (**Appendix** "E").

Also updated is the Council's Organisational Structure (included in the Council's Reviewed Workforce Management and Development Plan 2017 – 2021 (**Appendix** "C") reflecting recent changes in the human resource and procurement functions. The appended Long Term Financial Management Plan has also been updated to reflect the flow-on effects of budgetary change to the publicly exhibited Operational Plan 2020/21 budget.
